OTHER POSITIVES:

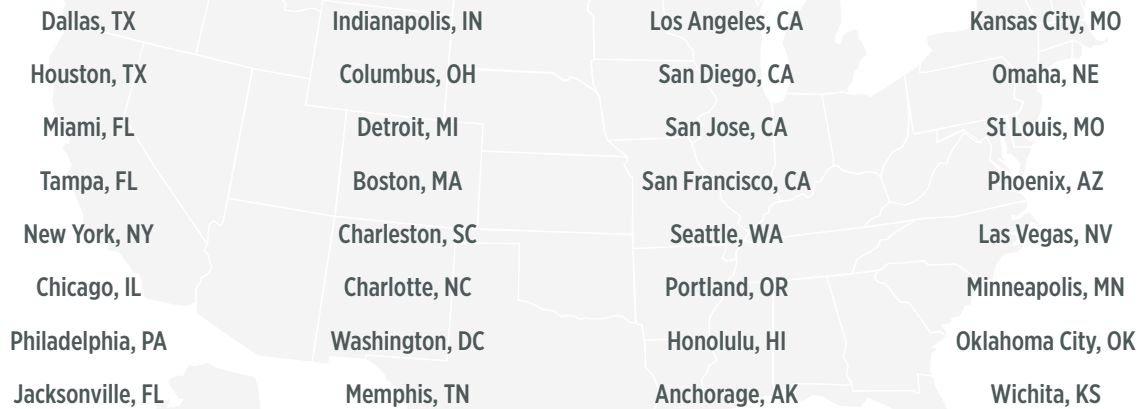
- Ability to work short-notice assignments of various lengths
